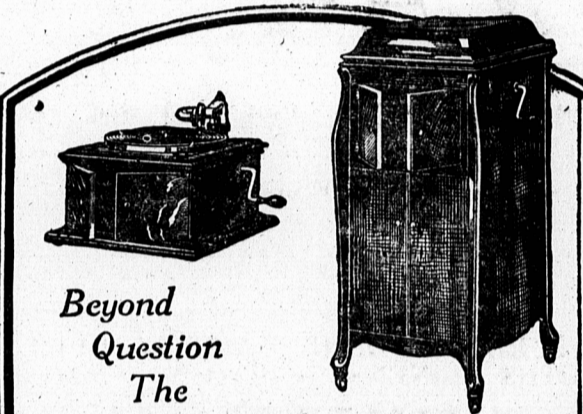

A REMARKABLE BRITISH BUDGET.

Little noted abroad because of anxiety over the reparations issue, less noted even at home than it should be by reason of the coal crisis, the British budget balance is again a feat of constructive statesmanship worthy of the highest admiration.

To have estimated the total revenues in advance within one-half of 1 per cent. is itself a feat sufficiently marvelous in comparison with the haphazard calculations of Albany or Washington. But the wresting of a surplus revenue of \$920,000,000 from the fiscal confusion of the day is the final test of Mr. Chamberlain's work.

It is true that a somewhat larger sum was derived from loans, and the sale of war property left unused, but the permanent national debt was reduced to an extent of nearly \$200,000,000 in excess of new obligations. War material for sale is a fading resource, but Mr. Chamberlain has thought of that; also of the fact that interest on public American debt is now to be paid—and a reduction of \$880,000,000 in expenditures is planned, again worthy of Washington's consideration.

The budget is bitterly assailed, for political purposes naturally, and also by business men, who say that the "breaking point" in taxation has been reached. But it shows a country that is solvent in spite of enormous war losses. Before American bankers talk too positively of holding the financial centre of the world in Wall Street, let them consider the advantage to private finance of London's habit of facing monetary problems with vision and courage, are of public finance that joins hands with statesmanship.
