CHINESE WOMAN 'FRISCO DELEGATE

China's outstanding woman educator, Dr. Wu Yi-fang, President of Ginling College for Women, is one of the ten Chinese delegates chosen to attend the San Francisco Conference of the United Nations. Miss Wu has been a member of the People's Political Council since 1938, and one of its presiding officers since 1940, the highest public office held by a woman in China.

Representing China abroad is no new role to Dr. Wu. In 1929 and again in 1938, she was one of the Chinese delegates to the Institute of Pacific Relations Conference, and in 1933 she represented China at the International Congress of Women in Chicago. She has been a leader in Christian work in her country, as well as in the political field.

A woman in her early fifties, Dr. Wu is small, thin and full of drive. She is a graduate of Ginling College, of which she is now president. Later she came to the States to take her M.A. and her Ph.D. at the University of Michigan.
