EUROPEAN NEWS
PARIS, Oct. 29. (Special)—The question of the regulation of traffic in the streets of Paris is always with us. Not a day passes without its melancholy rubric of accidents. Newspapers have taken up the question, and now the Government is beginning to move. A few days ago M. Jean Dupuy, Minister of Public Works, issued a manifesto in which he ordered an investigation into the conditions under which the license is granted to chauffeurs, and suggested that the required tests should be made more complete and stringent. He also advised the withdrawal, temporarily or completely, of the license of such drivers as had been implicated in a series of accidents.
