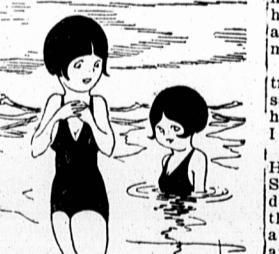

Canada's Farmers To Be Protected

Premier Meighen at Falls Picnic Reaffirms His Stand on Tariff.

NO DUMPING BY U.S.

Customs Wall in Dominion as High as That Erected Against Her.

NIAGARA FALLS, Sept. 9. — Certain Liberal speakers who have been charging Rt. Hon. Arthur Meighen with deserting his protective tariff campaign of last Fall had their answer at this point this afternoon, on the occasion of a big rally of the Conservatives of the Centre West District ridings, when several thousand citizens gathered in Queen Victoria Park to hear the election message of the Premier.

Mr. Meighen pointed out, as he has done on other occasions, that if there was one class of the community which must be protected in order to fight out the battle of existence on a level with the United States, it was the farmers.

Will Be Reasonable Tariff. "Yes, please," he declared, "if we are given a majority in the House, to revise the tariff on a definite protective principal in order that protection may be applied to all Canadian products."

The Premier went on to point out, that under the regime of the King, the farmers of the Dominion had fought an uphill battle against the invasion of produce from the United States; and he wondered if it were generally appreciated that since 1922, during the period of the King administration, the \$149,000,000 worth of United States farm products had been admitted into Canada, at a time when the American markets were particularly barred to the corresponding products of the Canadian farmers.
