REPORTED WOUNDED - Mrs. Louise Jay, 31 Gerald St., has received word that her son, Pte. Eric C. Jay has been severely wounded in the left hand while serving in action overseas in Holland. He is the son of the late Mr. Cyrus B. Jay.

RECEIVES COMMISSION - Dr. and Mrs. C. Keating, Keating received word that their son Kinball received a commission in the Royal Canadian Artillery in February, Lieut. Keeping enlisted in the 2nd Heavy Anti-Aircraft Regiment in June, 1941. He went overseas the same year and served in the defense of London. He was later transferred to a radio-location unit. He is twenty-two years of age.
