#### SOLD HIS MUSICAL HEART.

**St. Lewis, March 30.**—Edward Lewis, a Pole who recently gave an exhibition of his "musical heart" at the **Marion Sims Medical College** in this city, says he has sold his heart to the **Johns Hopkins University** for \$5,000. Lewis says he received \$500 cash and an iron-clad contract whereby on his death his heart is to be turned over to the university intact, and the school will pay Lewis' widow \$4,500 balance due for the organ. Lewis is one of the few men living in the United States whose hearts make music as they beat. He says the peculiar sound made by his heart is due to a sabre wound received by him in the breast in Russia years ago.
