By the addition or removal of paris a new utensil serves as a coffee percolator, teapot or pitcher.

Extensive deposits of peat from which fuel oil can be obtained have been discovered in New Zealand.

An inventor has combined a chalk line and plumb bob, the former being reeled in a case like a tape measure.

The German city of Stuttgart is erecting its first skyscraper, a 16 story building to be used by a newspaper.

An insulated cover has been invented to keep milk bottles at an even temperature and protect them from insects.

The landing gear of an airplane invented in France can be dropped if it becomes necessary to descend upon water.

The bristles of a new shaving brush can be removed and spread apart for quick drying or a new set can be inserted.

With an area greater than the United States, excluding Alaska, Brazil has an estimated population of 33,000,000.

The amount of perfumes and toilet preparations manufactured in the United States has increased sixfold in ten years.

German police have developed a whistle to summon dogs which the animals can hear but which is inaudible to human ears.

A new kitchen utensil serves as a double boiler by insertion into a tea kettle, the lid of the latter serving for both.

A fibre resembling silk for use in making clothing is obtained from a species of nettle cultivated in China for the purpose.

A steel guard has been invented to be slipped over shoes worn by workers whose feet are liable to injury from falling objects.

Food sold in a store built over an abandoned silver mine in northern Ontario is kept fresh by cold air that rises from the shaft.

Electric heaters that can take current from city lighting circuits have been developed for warming motorbuses when standing idle.

French engineers have developed a gas turbine for automobiles and airplanes that operates at a speed of 1500 revolutions a minute.

For disposing of rubbish and garbage in homes a built in incinerator that is as tall and resembles a chimney has been designed.

Engineers who investigated have estimated that the water courses of Ireland could be made to produce 500,000 horsepower continuously.

To eliminate the danger of automobile tire blowouts a valve has been designed that releases air when sufficient has been put into a tire.

A German industrial plant has developed a system of vacuum cups that is better than slings for handling non-magnetic plates with a crane.

A new electric fan for ventilating residence rooms can be concealed in a chandelier and has a revolving reflector to break up all drafts.

A 400 acre zoological garden in

which the animals will roam at will being confined only by hidden walls and moats, is planned for England.

New York has almost half as many automobiles as all the rest of the world outside of the United States, and California ranks a close second.

In experiments with antidotes for snake poison a Brazilian scientist has found that each species of rattlesnake produces a different venom.

Though rigid enough to be handled with one hand when extended, a new six foot measuring rule coils into a case about the size of a watch.

Endless belt landing skids to take the place of wheels have been invented in France to lessen the danger of airplanes overturning on alighting.

A California inventor has given a sun dial a curved plate that can be adjusted for any latitude, enabling the time to be ascertained accurately.

The world's largest fresh water fish, the pirarucu, lives in the Amazon river and its tributaries and weighs more than 2000 pounds when full grown.

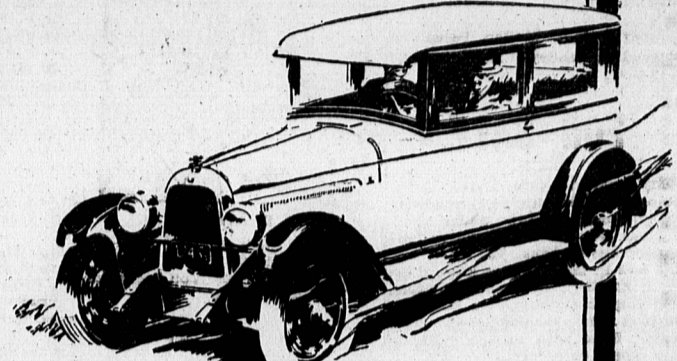
