 NEW YORK, Nov. 18 (AP)—A few steels, utilities and specialties edged up in today's stock market but the list as a whole lacked driving power.

Fractional advances in the Canadian list were scored by Distillers Seagram, Walker, Industrial Alcohol and Marconi. Dome Mines, International Nickel and Lake Shore Mines comprised the down trend.

The Associated Press average of 60 stocks ended up 1 of a point at 45.5. A month ago the composite stood at 44.4. Transfers of 547,050 shares were the lowest for a full session since Oct. 28. They compared with 1,050,090 last Friday.

Hogs were lower. Receipts, Cattle, 2,881; Hogs, 2,881; Sheep, 3,872.

Veal calves were about steady, other kinds 25 cents higher. Good veals made \$11 with a few tops at \$11.50, and medium veals \$10 to \$10.50 with common light kinds down to \$8.50. Drinkers were \$7.75 to \$8 and grassers made the bulk of the offerings ranging from \$4.50 to \$3.25 averaging close to \$4.75.
