Below will be found a brief synopsis of telegraphic reports received at the Head Office of the Bank of Montreal from its Branches. While conditions are fairly satisfactory in the Prairie Provinces, crops have suffered from intense heat during the past week, and good rains are required over large areas to avoid serious effects. The grasshopper menace has become serious, and is causing damage in scattered sections of all three Provinces. In Quebec cool weather and lack of moisture has retarded the growth of crops generally.
