TRADE CONDITIONS HERE.

Canada has expended hundreds of millions of dollars to build and subsidize railways, to dig canals, to give subsidies to steamship lines; and all this to facilitate trade. Some five or six millions have gone into our Island railway, approximately half a million into winter steamers, the interest on \$300,000 more into steamship subsidies for boats to ply between this Island and the Mainland. And with what result?

Just now and for weeks past the port of Charlottetown has been open; a canoe could navigate the blue waters of the harbor. Half the trade of the entire Province centres here, the exports of produce, the imports of merchandise. Our shippers and merchants want a steamer to carry their merchandise but cannot find one. Where are the Steam Navigation Company's subsidised boats? They are laid up for the winter. Where are the Government steamers? Plying leisurely between Picton and Georgetown, fifty miles away.

The shipping wharves are a part of the business centre of the town. Our shippers can stand at the wharves and look out upon the blue water at their feet and see nothing but a vast expanse of water. To get them away they must cart them to the distant freight sheds of the railway, have them loaded on the cars and sent to Georgetown, then unloaded and placed in the Government steamers. Passengers and mails must go the same way. Freight and passengers lose a day in going, a day in coming, and must pay the cost of fifty miles extra transportation.

All because of the crass stupidity or the callous disregard of those in authority who thus deprive us of the reasonable means of cheaper and direct carriage, with the means within their power. Everybody knows that in all these weeks since the Government steamers have been sent away, there has been nothing to prevent them plying to and from this port, where nearly all the winter trade naturally centers, and yet the conditions are as we have described.

Over three quarters of a million invested in steamers and subsidies for trade to and from the mainland; our principal port as open to navigation as in summer, and yet by Government neglect and mismanagement as effectively closed to commerce as if it were located beyond the arctic circle. These are the conditions that confront us a third of a century after we entered the union with Canada under terms that were to provide every facility for interprovincial trade. And this is the twentieth century!

What wonder that our people look upon the union with Canada as a bondage, a chain of servitude? Daily our money goes to build railways in and attract population to other Provinces of Canada, while our own Province is being depopulated, our industries dwarfed and starved, our trade paralysed. Prince Edward Island is being made the Ireland of Canada, without any of the ameliorating conditions which are now making Ireland habitable. These are the cold facts, painfully real to every man, woman and child in this Province, and to which Ottawa is callous and utterly indifferent.

Our province is small and our population few. Relatively small in the hand of a man to the size of his body, but a man may have a pain in his hand which will make his entire body uncomfortable. We again warn the Government that Prince Edward Island cannot be kept in the union under such conditions as now exist. We are a patient people, but a generation of misrule has exhausted our patience. We have a hundred reasons for secession than Nova Scotia had when Mr. Fielding carried the standard of revolt.

The other day Lord Rosebery, a past Premier of Great Britain and Ireland, openly hinted that Scotland might burst the bond of union with England if the policy of removing the Scots Greys from the Northern Kingdom was persisted in. What language would Lord Rosebery hold if by the neglect of the Government the trade and traffic of Scotland were shackled and paralyzed as in our day if Glasgow were isolated as Charlottetown is today? We must have reasonable trade facilities, now denied us. We will not remain in the union merely as taxpayers, denied all the fruits of union shared by the other Provinces. To submit longer to such conditions would be to confess that we had lost our manhood.

Since the above article was in type the S. S. Stanley has been ordered to this port, a name's sake.

The Patriot in an editorial paragraph expresses its condemnation of anonymous letters and yet almost every day prints letters of this class. In the next editorial note preceding its reference to this subject it explains about a letter it had before printed over the signature of "Onlooker." If it is "unfair and unmanly" to write and print such letters, why does The Patriot do so? "First cast out the beam out of thine own eye," gentle Patriot.

The Guardian has nothing to do and desires to have nothing to do with the family quarrel among the members of the Liberal party. So far the kickers do not seem to have accomplished much. To our mind the one great question is our winter disabilities, and we would like to see all parties united to work for better things in that regard without bickering over matters of relatively small moment.

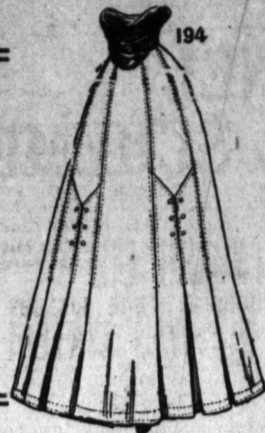
