The latest news, first of all. Bruce McKelvie, Summerside, left on Saturday on return to New York, after a short visit to his home in Summerside.

The lobster fishing on the North Shore showed no improvement last week. The lobsters this year are a fair size but the catch can be put down at about one half of that of last year. Codfishing is very encouraging and some taken last week were of an immense size.

The ferry steamer Bedque, made a special trip from Summerside to Cape Breton on Saturday afternoon last taking over U. N. Dupont of Montreal, who on account of having to give evidence in the Supreme Court, did not finish in time to connect with the Empress. The Bedque returned to Summerside about 5.30 the same afternoon.
