PROF. H. H. DEAN. Who Made Tour of the Province with the "Traveling Dairy." The name of Prof. H. H. Dean, the subject of the illustration, was brought prominently before the Province a few years ago through his tour of Ontario with the "traveling dairy." The results of the work then done are now being reaped in an improved quality of butter from the farmers' dairies generally. Prof. Dean was born on a Brant County farm 35 years ago, and graduated from the Agricultural College, a. B. S. A., in 1889. After a course in dairying at Geneva, N. Y., he returned to Guelph in 1890 to succeed



Prof. H. H. DEAN. Prof. Robertson as professor of dairying at his alma mater. Under his management the school has greatly prospered, until now its graduates are found in every county in the Province. As Prof. Dean has thus given instruction to a large percentage of the cheese-makers of Ontario, and as the Canadian exports of cheese have recently increased at the rate of \$1,000,000 a year, reaching now \$20,000,000, he has exerted a distinct influence on agricultural progress. At the college studies he has by careful selection of dairy cows brought the average milk production up to 9,000 pounds per year, while the average throughout the Province is less than 4,000 pounds.
