NEW YORK, Jan. 23.—Passengers on a Brooklyn ferry-boat today saw a man conspicuously swimming through the ice fields in the harbor. He refused help from the ferry-boat, swimming around it and making for a Brooklyn dock. When he was drawn to the dock from the icy water it was found that he was a Russian sailor with a remarkable tale.

"I shipped from here yesterday on a tramp fruit steamer," he said, "and when we were outside of Sandy Hook and I was standing on the poop deck someone comes up behind me and hits me on the head with a mauling pin. Overboard I went, and as I had a furnished room in Brooklyn I started to swim for there.

"I could have landed at Staten Island, or Governor's Island, but the tide was carrying me straight for Brooklyn, and as that was where I wanted to go I stayed with the tide. When I became tired I grabbed a cake of ice and rested. I don't know how long I was in the water, but I guess it was most of the night."

It is believed that the sailor swam more than ten miles through the ice floes.

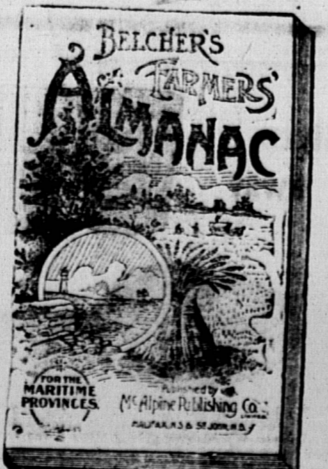
