In June, loadings were 9,012,000 and in July last year, 7,759,000 tons. This brought total loadings for the first seven months of the year to 53,700,000 in the similar period last year.

**July Steel Production**

OTTAWA, Aug. 22 (CP)—July production of steel ingots totalled 226,489 net tons, slightly under the June total of 230,581 tons, but well above last year's July total of 139,754 tons, the Dominion Bureau of Statistics reported today.

During the first seven months of the year 1,667,920 net tons were produced against 1,333,551 in the similar period last year.

**Output of Motor Vehicles For June**

OTTAWA, Aug. 22 (CP)—Although dropping slightly below the previous month's output, factory shipments of Canadian-made motor vehicles in June remained higher than at the same time last year, the Dominion Bureau of Statistics reported today.

During June, shipments of 21,137 units compared with 21,665 in May and 15,285 in June last year, bringing shipments during the first six months of the year to 126,215 units against 79,789 in the corresponding period of 1946.

Of the June total, 14,465 were passenger cars—11,445 for sale in Canada and 3,020 for export. Truck shipments during the month were 6,599 units, with 4,430 for Canadian consumption and 2,169 for export.
