On the second floor are carried Floor coverings of every description—carpet squares, rugs, oilcloths and linoleums. In these goods the firm does a very great business and buys direct from the leading manufacturers of Canada and Great Britain. Lace curtains, curtalnings, hangings and draperies of every description, window shades, upholstering fabrics, table covers and bedding are also located on this floor.

The immense reserve stock necessary to a large business of this sort is carried on the third and fourth floors; and additional space for this purpose is gained by leasing the upper flats of adjoining buildings.

It is gratifying to learn, in these days when so little manufacturing is being carried on in this Province, that this enterprising firm constantly employs a large number of skilled workmen and does a large amount of special order work, cabinet making and repairing. The work turned out is of the highest order notwithstanding the fact that in many instances the cost is less than would be the case were these goods imported from abroad. Furniture upholstering and mat re-making is also carried on and in this work also skilled labor produces excellent results.

Notwithstanding the fine large building the firm occupies, consisting as it does of four floors, an annex, and the top floor of the adjoining building—a total floor space of over 13500 square feet—the premises are still too small. A contract is shortly to be let which will materially aid in overcoming this handicap and make the store much more convenient and pleasant for shoppers.
