**Winnipeg Grain**  
WINNIPEG, Aug. 31 (CP)—  
Oats and barley futures scored  
modest advances in an active ses-  
sion on Winnipeg Grain Exchange  
today. Hedging pressure was sig-  
nificant in the early trading with shippers  
buying into both grains. American  
accounts were also active in  
oats while millsters were in the  
barley trade.  
In the latter stages of the ses-  
sion, however, hedging pressure  
increased and much of the early  
gains were reduced.  
In the trade hedging pressure  
was modest with American ac-  
counts absorbing most offers as  
prices advanced narrowly. There  
was considerable hedging of flax  
by elevator interests as prices  
continued their downward spiral.  
Some sales were made to export  
interests at the low point.  
It was reported that the Valcan  
was the buyer of 13,000,000 bush-  
els of wheat in the form of flour  
yesterday.  
Meanwhile, the United King-  
dom was reported to have lifted  
550,000 bushels of Canadian  
wheat under terms of the Cana-  
da-U. K. wheat agreement to-  
day.  
Class two wheat prices were re-  
duced two cents from yesterday.  
It was the first revision of class  
two prices in nearly a week.

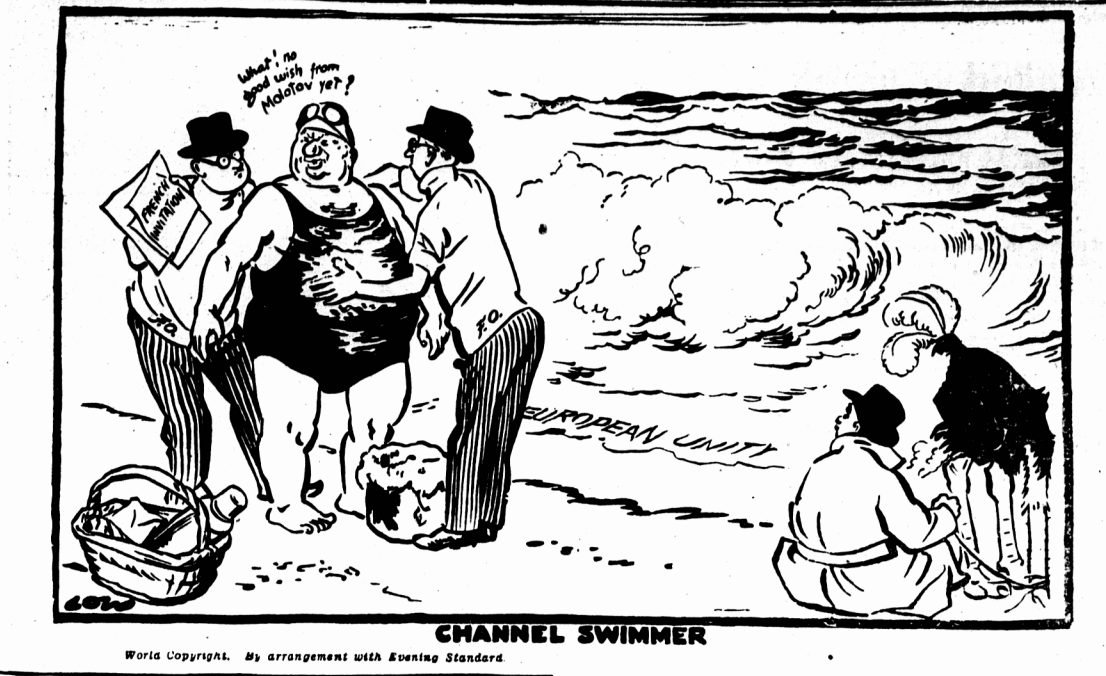
