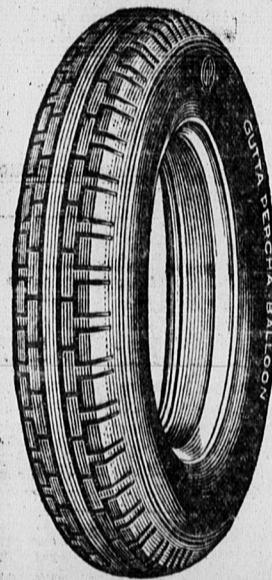

but even these may be made attractive if the right kinds of flowers are chosen. In fact, there are some plants such as tuberous-rooted begonias which actually prefer shade and will not do well unless they get it. Among those flowers which are recommended for partial shade are Nicotiana, Verbena, Phlox, Pansy, Marvel of Peru, Nemophila, Lupine, Larkspur, Godetia Clarkia, Alyssum and Candy tuft. Most flowers will hold their bloom longer and also their deep color if they have a little light shade, particularly around the noon hour when the sun's rays are most severe.

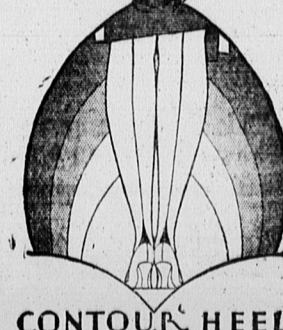
