### Prominent London Broker Arrested

LONDON, March 4.—An agency despatch from Naples says that Gerald Leo Bevan has been arrested. Bevan's connection with Ellis and Company, the second oldest firm of stock brokers in London, was explained at a meeting of creditors held in London today under the receiving order made against four of the partners of the firm, namely, the Hon. R. A. Fellows, N. F. O'Brien, H. H. Gordon and F. E. O'Toole.

A statement signed by them said Bevan became the senior partner of the firm about 1912. After 1912, Bevan assumed complete control of the firm's affairs and in conjunction with Pirie, the firm's managing clerk, conducted the financial arrangements of the firm, to the entire exclusion of the other partners. Bevan had not kept the partners duly informed of the general position of the firm's affairs nor of the transactions which should have been reported to them. From time to time Bevan would inform them he had undertaken some large transaction, say £500,000 or £1,000,000, in connection with some new issue. The other partners protested to Bevan, but without tangible result. Bevan always acted without consulting the other partners. During the period 1914-20, Bevan amassed a large fortune and Pirie stated he had made some £10,000 or £20,000.

### Petition To Save Murderer Fails

CHICAGO, March 4.—The most recent and probably the final attempt to save from the hangman's noose, Harvey Church, convicted murderer of two automobile salesmen, failed today, when his attorney was refused a petition for a writ of certiorari by Chief Justice Carter of the Illinois Supreme Court. The petition asked that an order of the insanity hearing in the criminal case be submitted for review. Justice Carter held he did not have the power to grant the writ.

Measuring Sheriff Peters made arrangements for the hanging on Friday of "Mentally Dead" Church. He will be carried to the gibbet in the county jail bound to a chair and hanged in that posture. In local history only two other men have been hanged bound to a chair. Jail physician McNamara stated positively that Church, who has been hunger striking, would "live to be hanged." Forceful feeding by the doctor continued today. A messenger from E. O. Church, father of the condemned man, appeared at the jail today asking permission to talk to Church.

"Harvey," said the warden, "here is Brigadier W. G. Anderson, of the Salvation Army, to see you. He is from your father." Church was lying on his back on the cell cot, his eyes closed. He made no movement.

### \$5,000,000 To Cover Canadian Claim

LONDON, March 2.—Moving a supplementary estimate of £2,250,000 in the House of Commons today, Hilton Young, Financial Secretary to the Treasury explained that £1,000,000 of this amount was necessitated by a claim from the Canadian government for railway materials supplied in 1916 for use on the western front in the war. The claim, he said, had been delayed owing to the Dominion's uncertainty regarding the future ownership of the railway whose material had been used. The claim now presented, said Mr. Young, should be met immediately.

TORONTO, March 3.—"So long as the prohibition law is being broken by blind pigs, bootleggers or rum runners, or so long as any province in the dominion is not bonded, our work is not completed," said Grand Councilor John Buchanan, of this city in his report to the Grand Council of Ontario, Royal Templars of Temperance, at the opening of its 39th-annual convention here yesterday.

The financial report was regarded as satisfactory, but there was a slight decrease in the membership of the Royal Templars.

Delegates from various sections of Canada are in attendance at the annual royal templars gathering.

With hugh crowds circling slowly outside the House, and with Whitehall one solid mass of motor traffic, the House was infected by the Royal Wedding spirit, and there was only a small attendance for the passing of the supplementary estimates but those present were faithful in the discharge of their duties and all items were closely scanned in the interest of economy.

### BIG FIGHT OPENS

WASHINGTON, March 4.—Fire on the four power pacific treaty was opened in the senate Thursday from both Republican and Democratic quarters when it was called up for debate after ratification yesterday of the Yap treaty. The debate, however, was declared to be only a skirmish with the real fighting scheduled for next week.
