SUNDAY SCHOOL LESSON

sion on the west of Jordan, within the land proper; first the portion of Judah, then that of Joseph, including the possessions of Ephraim and the half tribe of Manasseh. Then follow the portions of the other seven tribes in the following order: Benjamin, Simeon, Zebulun, Issachar, Asher, Naphtali, Dan. Immediately after this a brief paragraph records the setting apart of a special portion to Joshua. Finally we have the account of the appointment of the cities of refuge, and the other Levitical cities.

In the account of the portion allotted to Judah occurs the story of the special grant made to Caleb, in response to his request. After forty-five years he claims to him when the promise made to him when he stood by the side of Joshua, and testified to his confidence in the ability of the people in whom Jehovah delighted, to possess the land of the Divine appointment. The first impression made upon the mind may be that there was a touch of pride and of self-seeking in the request of Caleb. That, however, vanishes immediately when we carefully observe what it was that he really asked. He was of the tribe of Judah, and when the portion of Judah was allotted he at once claimed the most dangerous and difficult area in the inheritance of his tribe. He asked that he might be granted the territory of the Anakim, whom he undertook to dispossess in the strength of Jehovah.

The teaching of our lesson gathers about the person of this man, Caleb, in whom we see the principles of faith operating in full and splendid strength. Going back to the story of the sending of the spies in the first place, we find his quiet and calm declaration in answer to the objection of the spies, "Let us go up at once, and possess it; for we are able to overcome it" (Numbers xiii., 30.) The answer of Jehovah to that word of faith came when, uttering his sentence upon the men who dishonored His name. He said, "My servant Caleb, because he had another spirit with him, and hath followed Me fully, him will I bring into the land whereto I went; and his seed shall possess it" (Numbers xiv., 24.) Thus, upon the basis of his faith, God made a special covenant with him.

Now, as we have seen, forty-five years afterwards, Caleb claimed the fulfillment of that covenant, and he did so first by declaring that God had already been faithful to it; "Behold, the Lord hath kept me alive, as He spake, these forty and five years

the prices still remain firm, only the demand is slower. With this new condition arising, breeders are forced to produce high-quality animals, because they can be disposed of any time at fancy prices.

The farmer or breeder cannot select the mare, for he usually has the female, but the sire must be chosen to mate each time. Here is the breeder's opportunity and here often the breeder falls down. Unless he is experienced and a good judge of horses, the stallion in the community, fat and sleek, will look good to him. If placed beside another horse, and difference in conformation, quality and price will be at once apparent. A horse-raising district has a decided advantage over a community where interest does not center around any one particular line of live stock. Buyers will go where the stock may be found in quantities, and in Ontario there are districts known as horse communities. In order that the farmers might have the use of the very best sires, instead of being influenced by flesh and shabby coat, a small horsemen's league might be formed in a district with enough members to afford the purchase of a good stallion, or better still, to elect their patronage to an individual member who would purchase a horse up to their standard and insure him a profitable fee. This system would standardize the type of animal and the one horse would better suit the community than the system had been in vogue for a few years than it did at first. Live-stock shows afford splendid opportunity to study strains and families of horse breeds, and there delegates might decide on a horse of character of a horse to suit the members of the league. Community breeding gives a place a name and a decided advantage over unorganized and individual efforts.

and now, lo, I am this day fourscore and five years old." Building his confidence, therefore, upon the word of God, and his experience of his faithfulness, and declaring that he was as strong as he had been when the covenant was made with him; he asked that he might have this difficult part granted to him, and that in order that he might still prove the faithfulness of God. "It may be that the Lord will be with me, and I shall drive them out, as the Lord spake. Faith in the hour of difficulty is that of a perfect confidence in the power of God, expressed in willingness to follow Him fully. That faith had been within him through all the years as a conserving principle, and had been answered by the power of God maintaining him in strength and vigor. It now asked a new opportunity to act to the glory of God, in a place of supreme difficulty, and his request was granted to him.

This faith in the case of Caleb is revealed as the principle which follows fully, waits patiently, and finally asks a new opportunity for its exercise, and gains a final victory. There can be no question that the central value of our lesson is expressed in these words of our Lord: To seek the Kingdom of God and His righteousness first, that is, as the matter of supreme importance, is indeed to follow the Lord fully. Such action may mean, as it constantly does mean, a long postponement of visible realization. Yet the postponement is never capricious, and is not delayed one hour beyond the period necessary for the outworking of Divine purposes by the very best means. All the things that Caleb really needed during the period of his waiting were supplied to him. This is the point of the golden text. Not that he at last possessed his inheritance in Canaan, but that his sustenance and his raiment were provided during the period of his waiting. The final value therefore of the golden text is that whereas the story shows how at last faith will reach its final possessions, the word of Jesus reminds us that the process of the seeking and the waiting, God cares for every immediate need, and adds to His children the things which they are ever in danger of being anxious.
