Ferguson, president, said: "Elastic and slide fasteners are the only things beginning to ease," he added.

OUTDOOR CHORE MITTS
To keep your hands warm while doing some outdoor chores, make a pair of mitts which will more than repay for your work. If the socks have somewhat matted, so much the better. First, turn the sock inside out, measure the length by running the hand into the sock, cut off round and sew across. To insert the thumb, make a cut from where the ribbing of the cuff stops toward the end of mitt lengthwise, about two and one-half inches long. From the top of the sock where the material is best, cut out a thumb, rounding the end and slitting the bottom (which is nearest the cuff) in a V shape. Sew up the thumb and pin the bottom of the V to the bottom of the cuff and sew the thumb in place. Turn the outside in and you will have a comfortable pair
