DO YOU DESIRE FREE DELIVERY?

Free delivery of letters by carriers appointed and paid by the Government is in operation in many cities of Canada. There is reason to believe that the system may be adopted here if the people express their desire for it.

WHAT FREE DELIVERY MEANS.

Free delivery means that responsible carriers, wearing uniform, and sworn to the faithful discharge of their duties shall after the arrival and sorting of each mail at the Post Office take the letters received and deliver them to the persons addressed at their homes or places of business. The city would be divided into, say four districts, with a carrier for each district. He would make his rounds twice a day, and if there was a letter for you at the Post Office would take it to you. Arrived at your house he would ring or knock—two short rings or two sharp knocks. You would know by the knock or ring that it was the welcome postman and the letter or parcel would be left. If you had a letter to send out you would hand it to him and he would post it for you. But he would call only at houses or places of business where he had mail matter to deliver.

These privileges would be for those on the carriers' lists. Any persons who chose could still receive their letters at the Post Office as they now do. The carrier service would not deliver the newspapers printed in the city. Letters posted in the city addressed to other persons in the city would not be delivered by the carriers unless prepaid by a two cent stamp instead of one cent as now. This is the only additional charge in connection with the free delivery system.

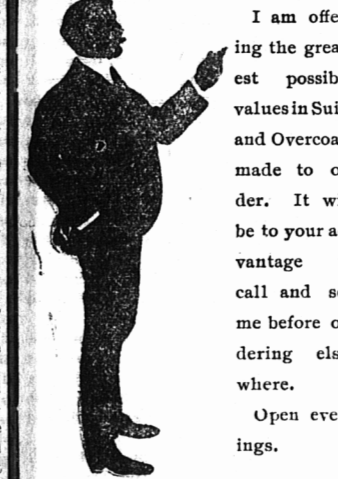

THE FINANCES OF THE FORESTERS

Investigated by the Financial Committee of the Supreme Court—The Report Submitted to the Members in Session Assembled.

REPORT OF THE FINANCE COMMITTEE.

To the members of the Supreme Court of the Independent Order of Foresters, in Session Assembled:

BROTHERS AND COMPANIONS—The Committee are convinced that the financial condition of the Order was never so strong as it is, to day. The Order may now be included among the number of the best financial institutions on the continent. Every Department shows the most thorough business management. The assets of the Order place us in a unique position among the fraternal societies of the world. There are in the National Fraternal Congress sixty-three societies, their accumulated funds amount, according to the last Report, to \$27,380,768.00. Our Order now holds \$9,000,000, leaving the balance to be divided among the sixty-two other societies. The increase in the accumulated funds of our Order since the last Supreme Court has been \$3,272,945.51. We believe that no other society anywhere can show such financial growth. This growth is not merely a growth in the amount of our accumulations but shows its healthy character when we compare the increase in our probable liabilities for the last biennial period with the increase of assets. Our increase per cent in probable liabilities amounts to 6.97. Our increase per cent in assets amounts to 31.34. Again, when we compare our assets per capita today with what they were four years ago, we have yet another illustration of our rapid development and increased stability. We have now \$40.00 per capita. Synopsis of Canadian North-West Homestead Regulations.

ANY even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba or the North-West Provinces, exceeding 8 and not less than 40 acres, may be homesteaded by any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section of land.

Entry may be made personally at the local land office for the district in which the land is situated, or by the homesteader's desire, by mail, on application to the Minister of the Interior, Ottawa, or the local agent or receiver, with some one to make entry for him.

The homesteader is required to perform the conditions set forth under one of the following:

(1) At least one residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year for three years.

(2) If the father, or mother, if the father deceased, or the homesteader resides upon a farm in the year of the land entered for the required period, the requirements as to residence may be satisfied by residence with the father or mother.

(3) If the homesteader has his permanent residence upon a farm in the year of the land entered for the required period, the requirements as to residence may be satisfied by residence upon the said farm.

Six months in writing should be given to the Minister of Dominion Lands in Ottawa to apply for patent.
