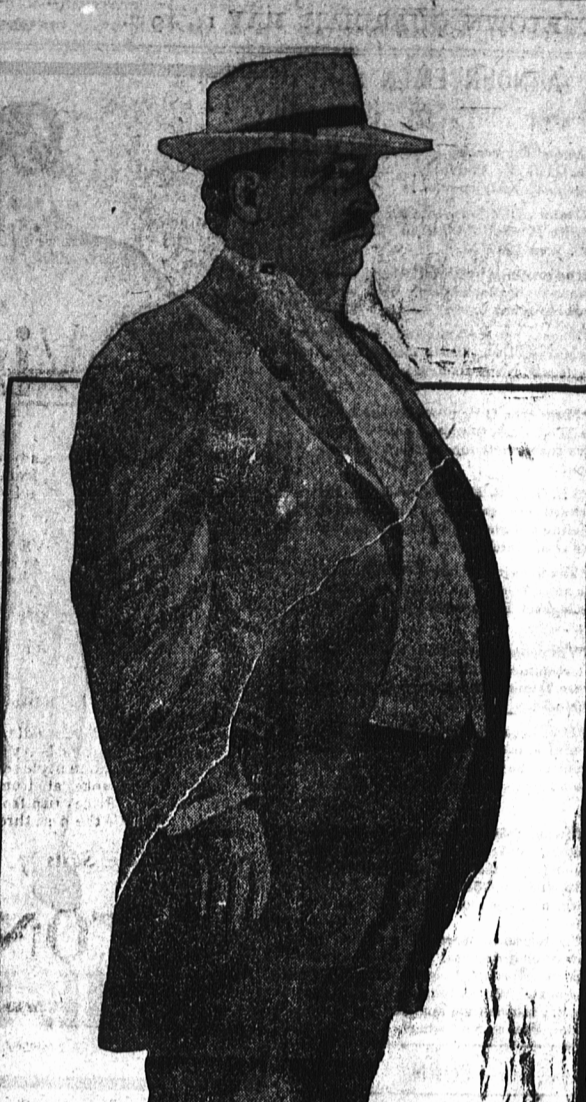

VIENNA, May 11.—The house which Countess Vilma Festetics settled upon her gypsy husband, Rudolf Nyari, after she eloped with him, is no longer his. The house was given to the Countess in anticipation of her marriage to Count Spreti, to whom she was engaged at the time she met the gypsy musician, but now, on the ground that her marriage to the musician makes her unworthy of belonging to the Festetics family, her father, Count Paul Festetics, has revoked the gift. This is in accordance with the Hungarian law. The Countess is therefore penniless. It is stated that Nyari has been promised an engagement in New York at a salary of \$30.00 a night.

THIS VOLCANO A SUBMARINE

LORENT, France, May 10.—Several trawlers came in here yesterday reporting the observance of an extraordinary phenomenon at sea which would appear to have been a submarine volcano eruption. The occurrence took place at a point forty-four miles southwest of the island of Groix, and sixty miles west of Belleisle. The men on board the trawlers noticed bright flames and intense smoke rising from the sea. Believing that some vessel was on fire, the trawler Kervel worked her way in that direction for the purpose of rendering assistance. She could however, discover no ship on fire. The fire and smoke, from no apparent cause, continued throughout the night, becoming more violent toward morning. The Kervel steamed away to ensure her own safety.

BROWN TAIL MOTH IN NOVA SCOTIA

HALIFAX, N.S., May 11.—The brown tail moth, one of the worst pests that orchardists have to meet, has made its appearance in the Annapolis Valley of Nova Scotia. A specimen of what was thought to be this insect was discovered some weeks ago in Kings county and was sent to the agricultural department at Ottawa for report. Principal Cumming of the Nova Scotia Agricultural College, says this is the first invasion of any part of Canada by this pest, and adds that the danger that it will spread and do untold damage is very real. He is sounding an alarm and calling on all farmers and orchardists to be very vigilant in searching for the insect and destroying it. He tells them that in this way alone can the splendid orchards of the Annapolis Valley be saved from terrible ravages.
