## FINANCIAL NEWS BRIEFS

**MONTREAL, Oct. 21**—Shawinigan—Nine months ended Sept. surplus before depreciation and income taxes \$3,095,056 against \$2,658,000 equivalent to \$1.42 and \$1.22 per share respectively.

McIntyre Porcupine—First half fiscal year ended September net earnings after depreciation and taxes equalled \$2.20 per share against \$2.24 same period last year. September quarter \$1.13 against June quarter \$1.07 per share.

Dome Mines—Nine months ended September net profit before depreciation, depletion and surplus adjustments \$3.37 per share compared to \$3.18 same period last year.

Newsprint—R. O. Sweezy, company's letter says publisher large newsprint reserves exaggerated, he estimates end of year publishers stocks will be about 40 days supply or only 7.5 days supply above 1933 36 average.

**MONTREAL, Oct. 21**—Union Gas—Declares 20 cent quarterly dividend payable Dec. 15 to 15 cents Nov. 20, an increase from 15 cents per share in previous quarter. Total declarations to date 50 cents against 47 1-2 cents per share paid in fiscal year ended March.

Shawinigan Power—Third quarter gross practically unchanged but due to higher operating expenses, taxes and cost of power purchased net operating was lower at \$1,889,991 from \$2,021,892 a year ago with surplus subject to depreciation and income tax at \$892,095 and \$1,010,739 respectively.

Saguenay Power—Third quarter net profit \$432,935 against \$356,296 in June quarter, after preferred dividends equalled \$1.37 per common share against \$1.37 respectively. For the nine months net profit \$1,130,995 equal to \$4.40 on common.

**MONTREAL, Oct. 21**—(CP)—Butter prices improved on Montreal open produce markets today. Trade expanded.

No. 1 butter in carlots or less were quoted at 26-28 1-2 cents a pound while lots to retailers were 26 for solids and 29 1-2 for prints.

Graded egg shipments were quoted at 40 cents a dozen for A-large, 38 for A-medium, 32 for A-pullets, 27 for B-large and 21-21 1-2 for C.

Cheese was quoted at 14-14 1-8 cents a pound for Ontario Oet-make, white and colored, and 14 1-2-3-4 for Ontario Sept-make Quebec Oet-make was 13 5-8-34.

**NEW YORK, Oct. 21**—(AP)—The Swiss franc, receding from yesterday's high for the year, led a general downward movement of leading European currencies in terms of the United States dollar today.

The Swiss franc dropped .06 of a cent, the British pound 7-8 of a cent at \$4.95 5-16 and the French franc .00 1-4 of a cent at 3.38 1-2. The Canadian dollar lost 1-64 of a cent at 1.00 1-64.

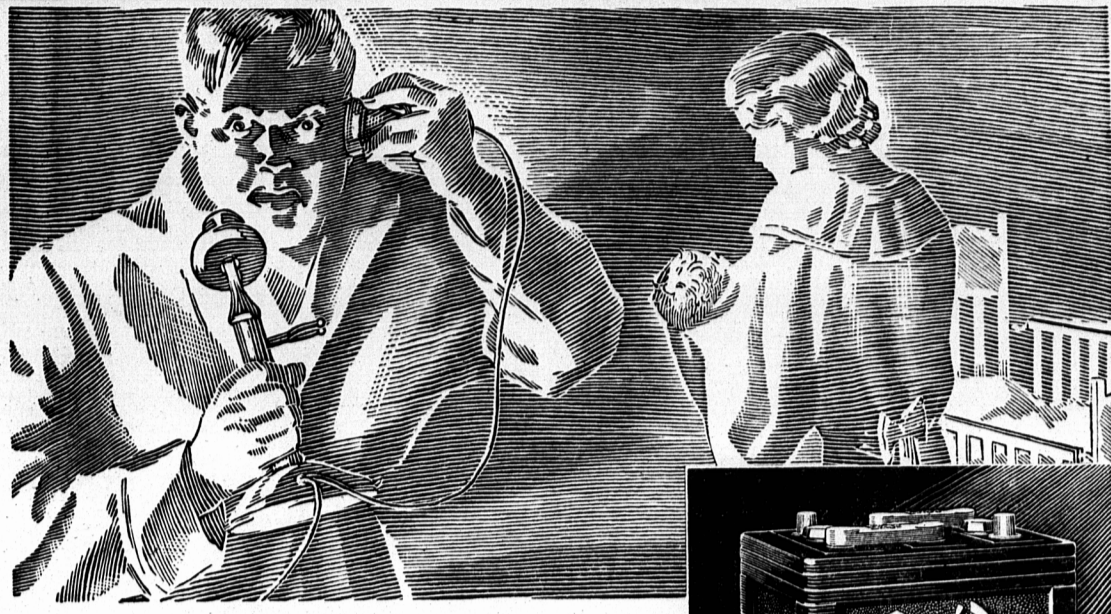
