NEW YORK, May 1—(AP)—Utilities and an assortment of blue chips today led the stock market on another selective upturn. Senior issues advanced as much as 3 points or so on small turnovers after an irregular opening in which fractional minus signs predominated. High marks were reached in many instances at the close and many industrials and rails ended a shade under water. Canadian stocks were uneven. Canadian Pacific, Hiram Walkers lost 1-8 and Distillers Sagrams shares 3-8 while preferred stock gained 2 points to 79 1-8. Brazilian Traction picked up 1-8 and Hollinger 1-16. Unchanged were Dome and McIntyre and International Nickel. Transfers totalled 300,670 shares compared with 278,620 Thursday. The Associated Press average was up 4 of a point at 33.1, its third successive day's recovery. Preferreds in demand included issues of West Penn Electric, American Power & Light, Engineers Public Service, United Corp. and Public Service of N.J.

NO PICK-UPS except of goods delivered in error, defective in quality, or too heavy or bulky for personal carrying.
