TO BUY PLAINS OF ABRAHAM

OTTAWA, Jan. 9.—Arrangements have been concluded for the conference of delegates from all the Canadian clubs, to be held in Ottawa, on Jan. 15 to devise ways and means for raising a fund of a million dollars by public subscription, to supplement grants already promised by the Federal and Provincial governments toward the conversion of the most important part of the battlefields of the Plains of Abraham and St. Foye, Quebec, into a national park, and the erection thereon of a monument to commemorate the reconciliation of the British and French race in Canada.

VACCINATION NOTICE

In accordance with the provisions of the Vaccination Act, 1886, the Superintendent of Vaccination for Charlottetown will be at the office of the undersigned, 178 Kent Street, on Wednesday and Saturday from 10.30 to 3.30 p.m. and 6.30 to 9 p.m.

The law requires that all unvaccinated persons of the age of three months or upwards, must be present to be vaccinated; children under twelve years of age to be brought by one of their parents or their guardian.

The charge for vaccination will be twenty-five cents for each person to be paid at the time of such vaccination.

Any person failing or neglecting to attend, or bringing his or her young child to the above time and place will be subject to the fines and penalties of the Vaccination Act.

Synopsis of Canadian North-West HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS.

ANY one numbered section of Dominion Land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta, excepting 8 and 28, not reserved for homesteading by any person who is the sole head of a family or any male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section 160 acres or less.

Applications for entry must be made in person by the applicant at a Dominion Land Agency or Subagency for the district in which the land is situated. Entry by proxy may, however, be made at an agency on certain conditions by the father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of any intending homesteader.

The homesteader is required to perform the homestead duties under one of the following plans:

(1) At least six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year for three years.

(2) A homesteader may, if he so desire perform the required residence duties by living on farming land owned solely by him not less than eighty (80) acres in extent, in the vicinity of his homestead. Joint ownership in land will not meet this requirement.

(3) If the father (or mother, if the father is deceased) of homesteader has permanent residence on farming land owned solely by him, not less than eighty (80) acres in extent, in the vicinity of the homestead or upon a homestead entered for by him in the vicinity such homesteader may perform his own residence duties by living with the father (or mother).

(4) The term "vicinity" in the two preceding paragraphs is defined as meaning not more than five miles in a direct line, measured at the width of road allowances crossed in the measurement.

(5) A homesteader intending to perform his residence duties in accordance with the above while living with a parent or other person owned by himself must notify the agent for the district of such intention.

Six months' notice in writing should be given to the Commissioner of Dominion Lands at Ottawa, of intention to apply for patent.
