MONTREAL, Nov. 27 (CP)—Selected industrials, scattered over a narrow list, were about mixed in quiet trading on the stock exchange and curb market today. Mines were dull and easier. 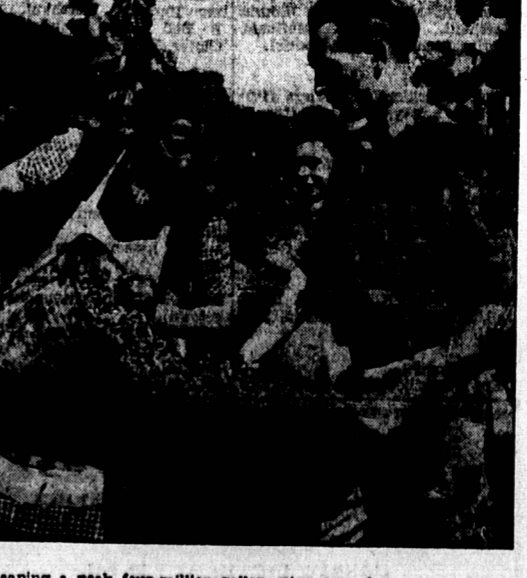
