Clergyman's Odd Hobby Is Hospital For Barrel Organs

LAWSHILL, Suffolk, Sept. 19.—To see even one barrel organ in a quiet Suffolk village four miles from the nearest station is odd, writes a Morning Post correspondent. When, however, you pass a second and a third within the space of a mile, all proceeding in the same direction, and find a lorry loaded with them standing by the roadside, it becomes something more than odd.

Ask a villager, though, and he will shake his head and smile. For to the inhabitants of Lawshill barrel organs have become as much a part of the landscape as their gigantic hayricks and the new-fangled harvesting machines, and a sudden burst of melody arouses no more comment than a road drill does in London.

To the village, from all over England, come old and derelict barrel organs to be repaired, and middle-aged ones to be equipped with new tunes. In next to no time a wheezy tinkling "I do like to be beside the seaside" changes to a sprightly "June in January" while "Rule Britannia!"—always a popular favorite—recovers a dozen or so missing notes.

It all started about ten years ago, when the Rev. A. O. Wintle arrived in the parish as rector, bringing with him a vast enthusiasm for organ grinders and their instruments. All his life he has been interested in this curious hobby, and probably no man in the world has a greater knowledge of his subject.

In practically no time two sheds in the rectory garden had been equipped as mysterious workshops. And then—the organs began to arrive and Mr. Wintle's reputation to grow.

Now over 30 people are employed by him assisting to put the "spikes" in the organ barrels which make the tunes. It is a delicate task, for one the slightest degree out of position means a discord and your true organ grinder is often a keen musician.

Mr. Wintle's art has changed little since the day, 163 years ago, when "Mrs Flights at Easter Church" inserted an advertisement in the very first number of the "Morning Post," reading: "Organ, barrel, finger, and machine organs made and repaired in the best manner, and barrels set to music. Second hand organs taken in exchange and bought and sold by commission."

For in spite of the lapse of time, and the coming of the gramophone and wireless set, there is still a demand, and a good one, for barrel organs—so long as they are well tuned.

Hope on Cards For Hauptmann Year in Cells. TRENTON, N. J., Sept. 19.—(A. P.)—Twelve months behind bars, seven of them with a death sentence hanging over his head for the kidnap-slaying of the Lindbergh baby, have done little to solve the riddle that is Bruno Richard Hauptmann. He was arrested Sept. 19, 1934. His year of legal strife has left him outwardly unchanged, save for the minor changes attendant on imprisonment. His hair is closely shorn today and his face has the pallor of the death house. But as he awaits the decision of the court of errors and appeals, expected next month, he is calm and as stoical as he was during his long trial at Flemington.
