**N. Y. Stock Prices In Slight Rally**

(By Victor Eubank)  
NEW YORK, March 4.—(AP)—Modest rallying propensities were displayed by selected stocks in today's market although dealings were among the slowest of the year and many leaders failed to respond.

Scattered steels, motors and rails led a brief upward flurry. In the second hour when early selling head evaporated, there was a slight pickup in activity for an interval then the ticker tape resumed its slumber. Extreme gains of fractions to a point or so were reduced in most cases at the close and minus marks held a shade the majority.

The Associated Press 60-stock composite was 70 .1 of a point at 66.5.

Canadian issues were mixed. Canadian Pacific gained 1-8 and Distillers Seagram moved up 1-4 while Dome Mines fell 3-4 and Mr. Intyre dropped 1-2. Hiram Walker was unchanged. On the curb, Lake Shore gained 1-4 and Giant Yellowknife moved up 1-8.

Eastman Kodak off about 3 at one time, pushed up at the last and ended with a net advance of 3 5-8 at 246 1-2.

Chrysler was up 1 at 99 and U.S. Gypsum 1 3-4 at 103 3-4 lesser gainers were U.S. Steel, General Motors, N.Y. Central, Southern Railway, Great Northern Railway, Pennsylvania Railroad, Northern Pacific, American Woolen, Phelps Dodge, Westinghouse, Montgomery Ward, U. S. Rubber, International Harvester, Union Carbide and Air Reduction.

Norfolk and Western was off 2 at 243, American Can 1-8 at 97, Dupont 1 at 188 3-4 and American Telephone 3-4 at 168 3-4, on the downside were Goodyear, Sears Roebuck, Douglas Aircraft, West-ern Union, Anacosta, Kennecott, Americas Smelting, General Electric, Union Pacific, Philip Morris and Standard Oil (N.J.).

Montreal Power was again in the spotlight and closed at 24 1-4, yesterday's final price, after drifting between 24 and 24 1-4. More than 7,000 shares of this stock were unchanged. Southmount was also active and upped five cents. Shawinigan and Brazilian were unchanged. C.P.R. offset a slip in carriers and Commerce dropped a 1-4 rise in carriers.

Abitibi Preferred led a mixed paper section and was unchanged at 21 1-4. M and O advanced 1-8. International lost a lift and Powell River was steady. Consolidated was off 1-4, Brown and B. C. Forest 1-8.

Massey was the leader in an only moderately active industrial group and held steady at 22 1-2 after earlier losing 1-8. The preferred stock ended unchanged after a previous dip. Canadian Breweries erased a 1-4 loss in liquors.
