### Contract Bridge

#### TWO CHANCES

The declarer lost his sound game contract in today's deal, first through an unfortunate guess, but later through a bad play.

South dealer.

The bidding:

South's two notrump was distinctly shaded. West opened the diamond three. Dummy played low. East put up the queen, and South won. South now cashed the club ace and led low toward dummy. Obviously, he could have put in the seven-spot and forced East's king, but he could not know this and made the unlucky guess to play the queen.

East returned his top heart, and declarer properly played low. West won with the jack and led back the diamond jack. Dummy's king took this and the spade queen was now led through East, who refused to cover.

With two spade tricks assured, declarer now cleared away the established clubs, and he had to make a discard on the diamond ten. It seemed absurd (he said later) to hope for a heart lead up to his A-Q, so he threw away the queen of hearts, hoping that he would
