IMPORT OF WOOD PULP TO STATES IS REGISTERED.

WASHINGTON, D. C., Dec. 29.—While foreign nations are clamoring for the free entry of wood pulp and paper into the United States on an equality with Canada, the treasury department today decreased the supply which can be imported from Canada without duty through an order relating to the Indian lands of Ontario. In future wood pulp or paper made from the woods of these lands must pay duty because of the Canadian regulation prohibiting the exportation of wood cut from Ontario Indian lands for the manufacture of wood pulp.

This places these lands in the same class as the Crown lands upon which exportation restrictions are placed, and it is in accordance with the agreement with Canada.

DECIDE UPON THE OFFICIAL FLAG FOR CANADIAN NAVY.

OTTAWA, Dec. 29.—The government has decided upon a flag for the Canadian navy and a description of the bunting will be published in the Canada Gazette tomorrow. The order is that "All ships of the Royal Canadian Navy shall fly at the stern the white ensign as the symbol of the authority of the Crown, and as the jack staff the distinctive flag of the Dominion of Canada, such distinctive flag being the blue ensign with the arms of the Dominion inset in the flag. The white pennant will be flown at the masthead."

REV. A. SHATFORD MAJORITY CHOICE

MONTREAL, Jan. 1.—By 107 votes to 23, the congregation of St. James the Apostle, at the vestry meeting Friday night, signified their desire to have Rev. Allen P. Shatford as their rector, in succession to the late Canon Ellegood, and it now only remains for the Lord Bishop of Montreal to confirm the selection.

At the vestry meeting held last Thursday evening, the names of nine clergymen were selected for presentation to the Bishop by the committee appointed for that purpose, but as such a large list was presented it is understood that His Lordship suggested the advisability of the congregation being asked to take another vote, with a view to narrowing down the list. This was done last night, and at the first ballot Rev. A. Shatford secured 107 votes and Canon Shreve, of Sherbrooke, 23 votes. The number of qualified voters totals 240, but, owing to the holiday season, only 130 were present.

The second ballot taken to decide upon an alternative resulted as follows: Canon Almond Shreve, 35; Rev. Moore, 1; Rev. Almond, 10; Rev. Caryle, 2; Rev. Bruce, 8; and Rev. Bidwell, 7. This is not a heavy poll, as a number of the voters withdrew after Mr. Shatford's nomination had been put beyond question.

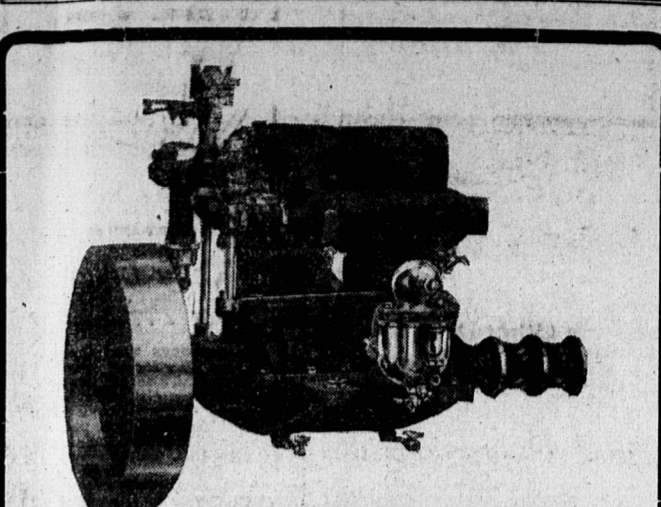
