S., where he had been stopping with his daughter. His death took place yesterday as the result of kidney trouble, the disease having reached the acute stage on Good Friday, since which time he had

been very ill. Mr. Inglis was 68 years of age and was a man of a quiet unassuming disposition, well liked by all who knew him. He leaves to mourn two sons John and Robert, both of whom accompanied the body to this city. The funeral will take place from his son's residence, Spring St. today at 3 p. m. to Peoples Cemetery.

**THE DERRY STUCK.**—The gasoline launch Derry, which plies between West River and Charlottetown, started making trips on Monday last, yesterday when on the return trip she became stuck in the ice between here and Rocky Point. The Tug Wm. Aitken went to her assistance and towed her to Rocky Point from where she proceeded without difficulty. The Wm. Aitken is now plying between Charlottetown and Rocky Point and will continue to do so until the ferry steamer Hillsborough is ready, which will likely be two weeks or more.

**LONDON, April 2.**—When the Montenegrin trouble is over it is likely the powers will have to deal with Serbia.

She has informed the British Minister that it is impossible to withdraw her troops from Scutari as Serbia is bound to Montenegro until peace has been signed. Any drawing back at the present time would be the death knell of the Balkan Alliance. Serbia too is reported to be preparing for permanent occupation of Durazzo, this action being directly against the decision of the Powers.

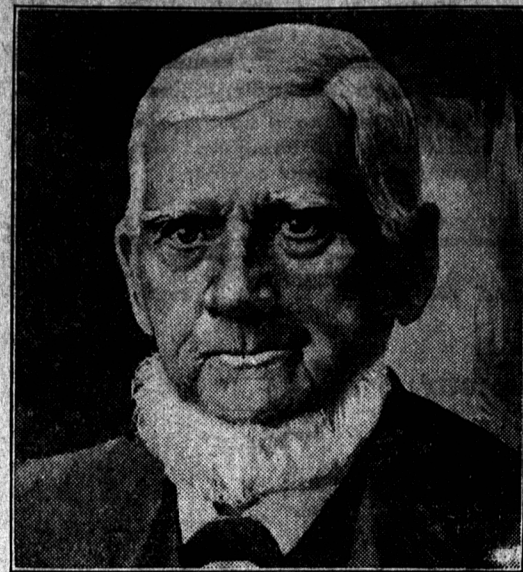
