BANK CASHIER TRIES SUICIDE

BIDDEFORD, Me., Aug. 30.—Richard H. Ingersoll, deposed treasurer of the York Savings Bank, who almost simultaneously with the announcement that the bank shortage would reach \$300,000 attempted to take his own life by cutting his throat.

Bank Examiner Skelton said tonight that he expected to have another supplementary statement ready within a few days, and that later when his work is finished and he and the officials know just how matters stand a full statement telling just what the shortage in the bank funds started and how it was covered up by the treasurer and other matters which have puzzled the depositors from the first, will be discussed.

HON. MR. PATERSON IS HOPEFUL OF INCREASED WEST INDIA TRADE.

OTTAWA, Aug. 30.—Hon. Wm. Paterson, Minister of Customs, returned to Ottawa last night after an absence of two months in Great Britain, where he has been attending the meetings of the imperial commission on trade between Canada and the West Indies.

Hon. Mr. Paterson says the report has been prepared, but as it was for the British Government he was not at liberty to disclose its nature. He would not confirm the report that the commission had been unable to discover a prospect for the development of a greater trade between Canada and the West Indies.

METHODISTS AND AMUSEMENTS.

The "footnote" abolished by resolution of the Methodist General Conference at Victoria, B. C., was as follows:

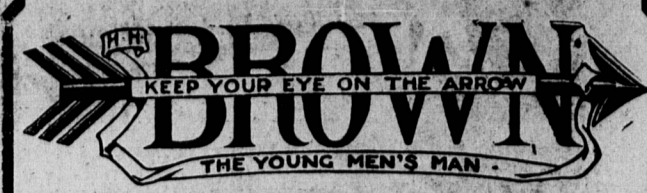
