**DYNAMITE BLAST KILLS TWO MEN**

HALIFAX, Dec. 10 (Special).—A dynamite blast at Lockport on MacKenzie & Mann's construction works yesterday killed two men and seriously injured another. The dead are Mark Day of Lockport and McFadden of Port Hastings.

The men had been warned of the blast and retired to a distance of over seven hundred feet, but were struck when the blast was discharged.

The group were started to see a block of stone fourteen inches square coming towards them.

They started to run but an instant later the mass of rock struck McFadden on the back and glancing struck Day on the legs, completely severing one and maiming the other.

Both died in a couple of hours.

Ernest Blades, who was struck by pieces of the breaking rock, is in a dangerous condition.

**A Caterpillar Farm.**  
 One of the wonders of Scarborough, England, is its caterpillar farm, a walled in half acre, on which rare species of moths and butterflies are reared with as much care as the poultryman gives to the prize fowls. Each female lays several hundred eggs. The feeding caterpillars are confined in muslin bags of "sleeves," and these are moved from place to place on the trees. The eggs, caterpillars and mature insects have considerable market value. Ordinary caterpillars sell at 5 to 50 cents each, and moths are not thought high at \$1, while certain hybrids sell readily at \$7.50 per specimen, and rarities are often taken at \$12 to \$15. For unusual colors the price may even reach \$100.
