CADET INSTRUCTORS COURSE.—A six weeks' course to qualify male teachers as Cadet Instructors will take place at Halifax, N.S. commencing on July 7th. The pay and allowance will be \$2.00 per day, the teachers finding their own board and lodging. Free transportation will be given to those authorized to attend, and return transportation to those who succeed in taking a certificate. Only male teachers who already possess a Grade "B" Physical Training Certificate will be admitted to the course. Applications to attend must be sent to the Education Office not later than June 18th. Each applicant must state his qualifications and give clearly his address and the station from which transportation will be required.

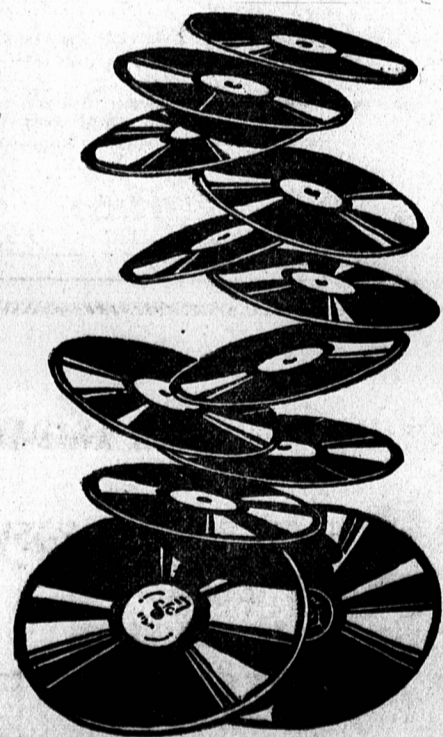
