AN ELECTION YEAR.

The Dominion general election, which was prepared for and so confidently expected last fall, will probably fall within the present year, which is also the time of the presidential contest in the United States.

Political considerations will therefore determine whether a federal election will be held this year or postponed till next year. But in these considerations the prospects of the several Liberal Provincial Governments will also count for something.

What Premier Ross's majority lacks in numbers it makes up in solidity. There is a sort of "don't give up the ship" air about it, and apparently the Government craft will keep afloat through the session at least.

Serious losses of stock on the Northwest ranches are reported as the result of a blizzard during the last week in March. Some herds, it is said, were almost wiped out.
