Q. I paid 38c a tin for grapefruit juice at the local store. We used to get it for 25c. Is there a ceiling price on this product?

A. Yes, the ceiling price on grapefruit juice. No dealer is allowed to charge more for it than the charged during the basic period, in the fall of 1941.

Q. I understand that the price of beef has been reduced. Is that right?

A. Effective July 3, a new order has a slight upward adjustment in the retail price of lean beef in the quarter-pound. Your butcher should display in his store the new authorized prices of all cuts.

FRENCH GRAY IS GOOD WALL COLOR

One happy color for walls in the industrial cities is the gray known as French Gray. It has been used several months of the year with comparatively little sunshine, and considerable fog.

Witt walls in this color, clear yellow taffeta or silk rep or watered silk give just the right French touch. Dirt resisting, such hard surfaced fabrics are the best selections for curtains and for upholstery.

Washing the family handkerchiefs can be unpleasant, but it doesn't need to be. Right before your eyes, day after day, handkerchiefs in cold salt water in their own separate pail. RASPBERRY TARTS

12 small tart shells
1 1/2 pint boxes of raspberries
4 tablespoons of sugar
1/4 cup of water
1 teaspoon of lemon juice
1 tablespoon of potato flour
1 tablespoon of water

Wash the half pint of berries. Add the sugar, water and lemon juice. Crush the berries and boil the mixture for ten minutes. Strain through a fine sieve—if you still own one. Stir the potato flour into the water and then add and bring to the boil again and then put to cool. Mash the other pint of berries slightly and mix with the mixture. Pour on the other mixture, which will form a glaze on the top of the tarts.
