Farm Loan Board Activities

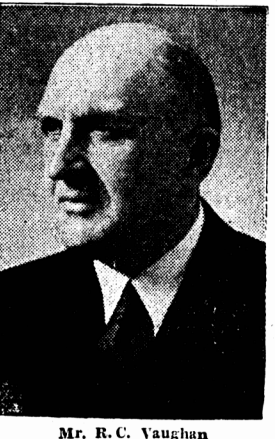
