LOBSTER MEETING.—A meeting of the lobster packers of Prince County was held in St. Paul's Hall, Summerside, yesterday, following the meeting of a similar nature that was held in Charlottetown on Wednesday. It was attended by about fifty packers of Prince County, also several from other parts of the Island, Nova Scotia and New Brunswick. Mr. A. King, of Halifax, occupied the chair and explained the nature of the meetings held at Halifax and in Charlottetown and the proposals made elsewhere for the conservation of the lobster industry and the betterment of those concerned in this important enterprise. The need of conservation, the protection of spawn lobster, and the prevention of illegal packing were discussed freely among other phases of the business, at both forenoon and afternoon sessions of the meeting, towards the close of which a committee of fourteen prominent lobster operators in this County was formed for the purpose of interviewing those packers who were not present at the meeting. At this committee's summons further meetings will be held from time to time. It is hoped that meetings of this nature will result in a better understanding among the different parties engaged in the business, towards conserving the supply for the future, with advantage to themselves, J.
