Broad Rally Is Noted On New York Market

NEW YORK, Oct. 15 (AP)—The Stock Market today put on one of the fastest and broadest rallying performances of the past month with the biggest average gain for 7 years in the wake of the President's edict decontrolling meat.

Transfers of 2,360,000 shares compared with 1,290,000 Monday and were the largest since Sept. 20.

The Associated Press 40-stock composite was up 24 points at 64.7, sharpest upturn since 5, 1939.

Hiram Walker's 6 point jump set the pace for climbing Canadians. Canadian Pacific went up 1-1/4. McIntyre 1, Distillers Seagram 5-8 and Dome Mines 3-8. On the Curb Giant Yellowknife rose 1-8 while Lake Shore slipped 1-4.

Packing house issues started an hour to an hour-and-a-half late on big trades as flour specialists were unable to co-ordinate heavy bids and offers. Armour came out on a 45,000-share block up 1-3/4 and ended up 1-1/2 at 14 5/8. Wilson & Co. on 17,300 shares up 2-1/4, with a final gain of 1-3/8 at 16 7/8. Cudahy on 2-500 shares up 4-3/4 with a net advance of 4-1/4 to 46 1/2 and Swift on 2,500 shares up 4-1/8 holding 3-1/2 at 98 1/4 at the last.

American Woolen Preferred was up 11 1/4 points at 159 and the Common 4 at 51. After the close directors voted a dividend of 812 a share on the junior issues first payment on this stock since 1924, and a disbursement on the preferred of \$68.50, representing arrears.
