ITALIAN CREAM

One lb. of icing sugar, two whites of egg, lemon essence, saffron, cochineal, and vanilla.

Beat up the white of one egg and mix with the icing sugar. Knead this until smooth with the hands...

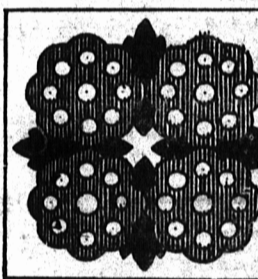
COFFEE BRAZILS Have 1 lb. of icing sugar, one white of egg, strong coffee essence, and shelled brazilis.

ALMOND ROCK Half a lb. of Demarara sugar, 3 ozs. of almonds, one tablespoonful of lemon juice, and one tablespoonful of water.

VERBENA Cut out applique pieces and sew as indicated on small block. Arrange applique and plain blocks as suggested on quilt diagram.

Block finishes 16 inches square. 22 applique blocks. 8 plain blocks. 3 inch border around entire quilt.
