ACCIDENT AVERTED—What might have been a serious accident occurred at Hampton a few days ago. Mr. S. D. Mr. Cameron was thrown from the machine but clung to the lines. Fortunately a part of the machine broke so that it was put out of gear and the horses after some difficulty were stopped. Mr. Cameron escaped with slight injuries.

POLICE COURT—At the Police Court yesterday morning a man named Doyle was convicted on a charge of drunkenness and fined \$5. Francis Power, on Tuesday was sentenced to ninety days' imprisonment for fighting on 18th inst., while for a similar offence committed on 2nd inst. he was fined \$20. A case of Benjamin Sheppard v. CANADIANS ANXIOUS TO RETURN HOME

LONDON, Aug. 5.—Despairing crowds of refugees mostly women and children, yesterday invaded the shipping offices here, particularly those of the North Atlantic lines, many of them being in a most precarious position owing to their failure to cash foreign monies on their hasty retreat from the Continent. Many passengers of means have found themselves penniless, while others with money were glad to accept third accommodation on ships this week.

An American doctor, a graduate of McGill, informed the Montreal Gazette that he was glad to take third class accommodation on the Tunisian sailing Wednesday next.

Among the passengers from France anxious to book to Canada, was Miss Monk, daughter of the late member for Jacques Cartier. One American gentleman who has just quitted Germany, declared that his automobile had been commandeered. Some comment was heard from a Canadian, anxious to get back, because of the fact that the High Commissioner's Office was closed on account of the bank holiday, whereas the American Embassy was active throughout the day and the consul comforted the crowd by assuring them that they would have food, shelter and protection under all circumstances.

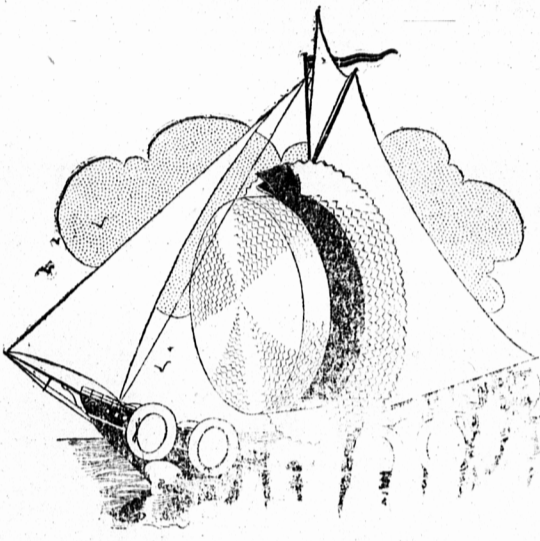
