## RETURN FROM CALIFORNIA

Mr. and Mrs. Mark McGuigan are being welcomed home from a six weeks visit to California.

Leaving here on February 11th, Mr. and Mrs. McGuigan first visited Boston and New York, leaving the latter city on February 16th, by the S. S. "California". After a pleasant sail of three days they landed at Havana where they spent a day. Taking a taxi they drove about this beautiful city leaving in the evening and three days later arrived at the Panama Canal at 8 o'clock on the morning of the 22nd. Going through the canal they left the ship at 1 o'clock p. m. and had until 1 o'clock the following morning to visit Panama. They drove about Panama by auto for about three hours then spent the time visiting this quaint old city with narrow streets.

Leaving Panama on the morning of the 23rd, they sailed without further stop, 2500 or 2600 miles until they reached San Diego, March 1st. About twenty miles from here is the Mexican border.

Securing cars they crossed the border driving to Tia Juana. As the regulations here state visitors must cross the border before 6 o'clock or remain all night Mr. and Mrs. McGuigan had only a few hours here. In this city is located the renowned race track and many gambling machines are in evidence.

The town is visited by many Americans—in fact the city has been practically rebuilt to resemble an American town. At the time they were there conditions were quiet, there being no signs of a revolution.

From there they left for Los Angeles arriving the following morning, remaining two weeks, being the guests of Mr. McGuigan's brother. While there they met Ezra McArthur, a brother of Senator McArthur of Sumnerside who drove them about an entire day in his car, showing them the homes of the movie celebrities, through the mountains, etc.

Mr. and Mrs. McGuigan also met here Dr. Vincent Trainor, who was the Governor General's medalist at Queen Square School and later a student at St. Dunstan's University. Needless to say Dr. Trainor has an excellent practice.

Los Angeles, Mr. McGuigan states, is growing very fast during the last few years and now claims a population of 1,400,000.

Oil wells and real estate is the principal business here and recently manufacturing plants have been opened for the manufacture of tars, autos, etc.

En route home Mr. and Mrs. McGuigan visited San Francisco where they stopped off a day. Here they visited the Golden Gate Park and other places of interest.

Their next stop was at Seattle where they met Glen Morrissey, formerly of Georgetown and a former S. D. U. student. They also had the pleasure of meeting Hon. Cyrus Crosby and his son Ernest. The elder Mr. Crosby is enjoying excellent health and inquired for many of his Charlottetown friends. His son Ernest is conducting a most successful garage business.

From Seattle they went to Vancouver and here they had luncheon with Mr. Alex Laird who has a large law practice. Mr. Laird was a former student in the office of McLeod and Bentley. They also met Mr. Leo Trainor, a brother of Mr. Joseph Trainor of the Charlottetown Post Office staff, who holds a responsible position with the Toronto General Trust Co.

The next stop made was at Regina where several enjoyable days were spent, and where they visited the new factory of the General Motors, which was only opened this year and where 1000 men are employed.

Other cities, Montreal, Ottawa, Toronto, etc., were visited before they reached the shores of the Garden of the Gulf, after enjoying every minute of their tour.

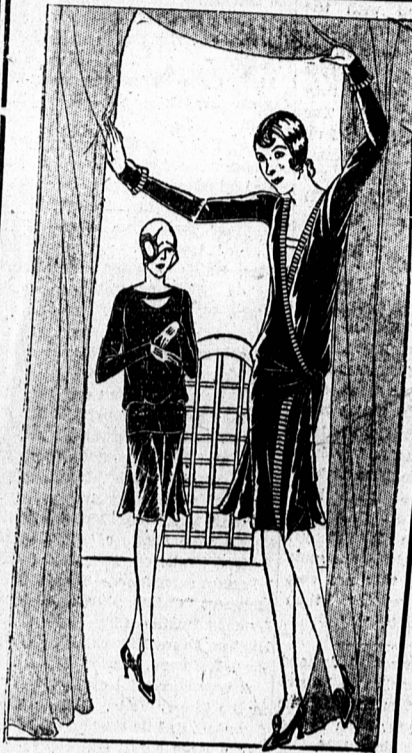

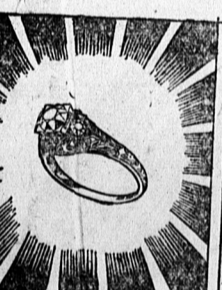
