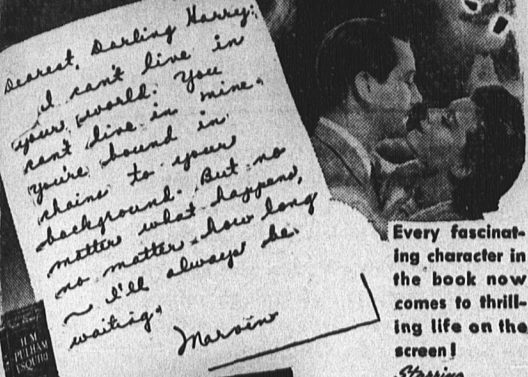

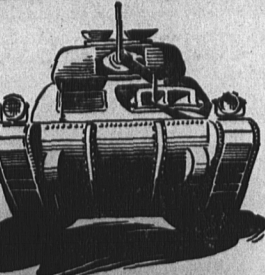
POLICE COURT - In the Police Court yesterday a man, charged under the Prohibition Act with having possession of beer, was fined \$25 and costs or 30 days in jail.

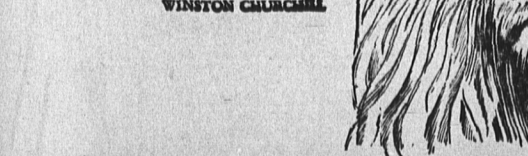
