THE C. M. B. A. Tea at Kensington which was to have taken place today is postponed till Tuesday the 29th inst. To take place under same arrangements as already announced.

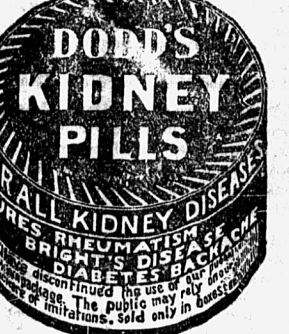

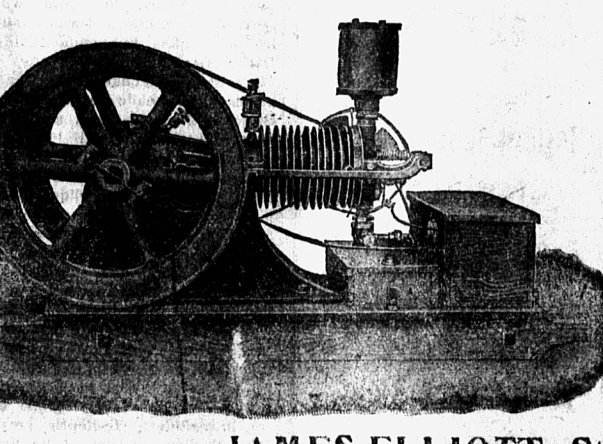
