Canada's War Chiefs

HON. CHARLES GAVAN POWER
 Minister of National Defence for Air

In his office at Royal Canadian Air Force headquarters Hon. Charles Gavan Power, Minister for Air, is a grim-visaged, dead-in-earnest administrator of a tremendous war undertaking.

But in his moments of relaxation "Chubby" Power is a jovial companion, a mirth-provoking after-dinner speaker and a master of repartee in political debate.

He was made Minister of National Defence for Air when the new department was created by act of parliament last May.

Two months later he was sworn in as Associate Minister of National Defence, an additional portfolio created to lighten the burden upon Defence Minister Ralston, who has general jurisdiction over all arms of the service.

Thus his full title is "Associate Minister of National Defence for Air." But nearly everybody calls him "Chubby" and he does not seem to mind, even when it comes from at a formal press correspondent.

The name "Chubby" was applied to him when he was a small, well-rounded boy at Sillery, a Quebec suburb where he was born Jan. 18, 1888.

It stayed with him through his college days when he was a star hockey and football player, through his service overseas which brought him the military stars and crisp line wounds, and throughout his long political career.

Now, nearing his 52nd birthday, Major Power is of medium height, well-built and jaunty in his bearing, active in movement, with his thick, dark hair is graying, as is his crisp moustache. He is somewhat swarthy and wears horned glasses at his desk. He swings these in his hand when in conversation or debate.

Of Quebec Family

The Powers have been prominent lumber dealers in Quebec for three generations. His great-grandparents on both sides of his family came out from Ireland near the close of the 18th century. Charles Gavan traced for legal practice and has devoted to that profession what time he has had to spare in 23 years' constant membership in the House of Commons.

When he became Air Minister, Major Power declared at once that he would have to learn from the ground up. He put in long hours at it and soon produced results. He is head of the \$850,000 commonwealth air training scheme launched last fall and designed to turn out great numbers of air personnel for the forces of Great Britain, Canada, Australia and New Zealand.

Germany's crushing defeat of the Low Countries and France forced a halt in British plane deliveries for the scheme and looked for a time as though it would be wrecked before it could get well underway.

"We're going to get those machines somewhere, and we are going to get this plan working in half time (three years) originally planned," Major Power declared. Recently he was able to announce virtual attainment of these objectives.

Major Power always felt a dislike for the so-called "brass hats" and frequently said so publicly. When he went into the defence department he felt a little apprehension on that score. But he found no "brass hats," as he has called them, in the air force and he has been happy in his associations with the great number of officers he has to work with.

Career in Other War

On Sept. 26, 1916, after a brilliant career of service in France, Major Power was severely wounded. He was being helped by a comrade to reach a dressing station near Regina Trench on the Somme, when a German stretcher bearer lost on rapidly changing field of battle, encountered the two Canadians and tried to give first-aid. A bursting shell killed the German and the other Canadian, and Major Power received further wounds.

After a year in hospital he returned to Canada unfit for further service. In September, 1917.

Three months later he was elected to the House of Commons as Liberal member for Quebec South and he has represented the same district from 1901 to 1917.

Major Power is fluently bi-lingual. He is a hard-hitting political debater and an authority on election legislation.

A newspaper writer said of Major Power, in 1933, that he was "the owner of as pleasant and friendly a voice as ever cast aspersions upon the honesty, wisdom and good manners of a Tory minister."

He has been a minister himself since October, 1935, when he was sworn in as Minister of Pensions and National Health. He held this portfolio because it gave him a chance to deal with war veterans' pension legislation.

At minister he won the respect of his former comrades in arms by his fearless advocacy of their rights, and his candid advice to themselves when he believed they were wrong.

He was Postmaster-General for several months last winter, by creation of an air ministry was already rumored and observers in Ottawa rightly guessed that he would be his head.

Major Power is a little drawn and haggard these days because his job calls for long and arduous toil. But his eyes still twinkle merrily when he has time to tell a new story and hear one in exchange.
