MILLIONS TO FLOW INTO CANADA

Bankers Say Hundred Millions Will Reach Canada This Year—Railways Will Require Enormous Sums Of Money For Work

MONTREAL, Jan. 27.—An enquiry at the banks here, as well as at the other financial institutions, elicits the important information—that no less than \$100,000,000 of new money will have found its way into the Dominion by the end of the present year, all of which being the direct result of the country's rapid yet legitimate development. This enormous amount which will be spent in the several Provinces of the Confederation during the year 1908, is exclusive of the proceeds of grain, lumber, pulp and other commodities of export.

Going into the matter in detail, it is estimated that the Canadian Pacific will probably bring in from \$20,000,000 to \$25,000,000 as a result of the new stock issue and the sale of other debentures. Then there is the Grand Trunk Pacific whose expenditure cannot but be very large during 1908. In fact the statement was made yesterday that after a very careful calculation that well on to \$20,000,000 will be brought into Canada to the credit of that Company during the present year. It is also believed that the Canadian Northern will be a very large spender during the coming summer, and the statement is made that the \$2,500,000 obtained a few weeks ago by William McKenzie, either in London or Paris, will be increased to around \$10,000,000 before the completion of the C. G. R.'s enterprises for the present year.

DANGEROUS SIDEWALKS.

These cost nothing but a little forethought.

SEED GRAIN FOR THE WESTENERS

Government To Assist Those Whose Crops Failed Last Summer

OTTAWA, Jan. 27.—The Dominion Government has decided to advance to those settlers of Alberta and Saskatchewan whose crops were affected sufficient funds to enable them to purchase seed grain. These advances will be made by way of a loan. It will take about five million dollars to finance the whole scheme. Seed oats will likely be purchased in Britain and probably in Norway and Sweden at once to introduce diversified cereal crops in the Western Provinces.
