PERSONAL TRAITS OF LORD SALISBURY.

Lord Salisbury as described by a recent article of Mr. A. Maurice Low, is aging fast, and though past the allotted three-score years and ten is older than his years. For two women he had the most passionate love and devotion—his wife and Queen Victoria.

It is said that few people in England know anything about Lord Salisbury and scarcely any one cares about him except as a statesman. This is his own choice. "He abominates the mob. He has never asked the populace to burn incense before him.

Lord Salisbury believes in the virtues of hereditary descent, is a natural aristocrat and clings to Toryism with unswerving devotion. These feelings he had and expressed in every line that he wrote when as a younger son he was dependent upon his pen for a living.

When it was proposed to repeal the paper duties, which meant a cheap daily press, he, who wrote only for the high-class journals read by the select few, said: "Could it be maintained that a person of any education could learn anything worth knowing from a penny paper?"

Many instances are cited in which Lord Salisbury has spoken in terms that in any other statesman would be thought to be

ill-advised. He openly expressed his pleasure at President McKinley's re-election, though, fortunately for the President it was when the election was over. A few years ago he publicly denounced the Sultan, though Britain was then at peace with Turkey and he was Prime Minister.

These range and seemingly ill-advised utterances are attributed in part to his cynical indifference toward popular opinion, and in part to the fact that he never prepares a speech. He has accustomed himself to "think standing" and deliver his thoughts as they are formed in his brain.
