THE GRAND TRUNK RAILWAY.

From "La Patrie" June 21st, 1910. The French Canadians now number two on the Directorate of the Grand Trunk Pacific. Alfred Brunet, who was named by the Government to represent it at the time it was formed, and the Hon. Raoul Dandurand, who was chosen at the last meeting of the Directors.

The nomination of Mr. Dandurand is welcomed with much pleasure in railway circles, where his talents and ability will be valuable in the direction of our National Transcontinental Line.

We are now represented in the two great Canadian Railways as we already have Hon. Senator Forget on the Directorate of the C. P. R.

HOLMER ENTERED FOR 12 MILE RACE AT BOSTON.

BOSTON, July 17.—Every long distance champion of note will be a starter in the twelve-mile special race at the Scotch games, Caledonia Grove, August 6. The entries to date include such well known performers as Alf Shubb, the British champion, Hans Holmer, the Canadian champion; Jim Crowley, the Irish Marathon champion; Jimmy Lee, the former B. A. A. champion, and Ted Crooks, of Fall River. Besides these, the entry of Gustav Ljungstrom and Johnson, the Swedish champions, are expected.

WORKMEN HAD NARROW ESCAPE

NIAGARA FALLS, July 17.—Thirty-seven men working at the bottom of a 100 foot shaft in the New Ontario Tower company's tunnel narrowly escaped death when the gate at the head of the tunnel a mile away broke early today. The rush of water was so heavy it impeded by debris in the tunnel and the men were taken to the surface in a hoist, half a dozen at a time. When the fifth and last trip was made the remaining seven men were standing waist deep in water.

TRURO LOST IN GOLF MATCH.

TRURO, July 17.—Halifax golfers won a decided victory yesterday over Truro devotees of the links. The Halifax men won in both the singles and the foursomes. The figures were not very high, and the Truro men did better in the foursomes than in the singles. In the Halifax party were Lieut. Col. Weston, J. L. McKinnon, George Taylor, W. A. Henry, J. H. S. McClure, Mr. Handsombody, Charles Stewart, H. H. Smith, Professor MacMechan, Owen Jones. This was a return match, the Truro men having been in Halifax the week before.

YONKERS, N. Y., July 18.—While in a race, following an encounter with an ice man in his home yesterday, Peter Tripoli, a retired contractor, took a large knife from a sideboard drawer, and ran towards his wife. The woman grabbed his hands and begged and pleaded with him not to harm her. He yelled at her, and tried to back her with the implement. She managed to load him for a while, but finally sank to the floor exhausted.

As the woman fell in a heap at his feet her husband, with a shriek, raised the knife above his head and brought it down toward her. Then he suddenly reeled and staggered back. The weapon fell from his hand, Tripoli, clutching at his heart, sank to the floor. Mrs. Tripoli, weakened by the ordeal through which she had passed, fainted.

Neighbors who had heard Tripoli's shouts ran into the house and when they found the man and wife lying on the floor, summoned Dr. J. A. Failla, the deputy health officer, who was passing. He said that the contractor had died instantly of heart disease, brought on by heart prostration. Tripoli had been complaining of the heat. He attacked an ice man with an axe during an argument over the price of a piece of ice just before he had attempted to stab his wife.
