

—The latest news, first of all.
 —Wm Dennis, O'Leary, has received another shipment of Foxes from the United States.

—The cold snap of the past few days has formed good ice in and around the rivers and bays of Prince County. Teams are now crossing to and from Bedouque.

—Thomas Humphrey, John B. Curtis, John Pickett and a number of others were in Summerside yesterday attending the funeral of the late John Pridham.

—The funeral of the late Jabez Pridham, Summerside, took place yesterday afternoon. A very impressive service was held at the Methodist church, conducted by the pastor, Rev Mr Johnson, assisted by Rev. Mr Strathie. The pall-bearers were J. A. Brace, D. A. Pickering, Thomas Glover, Frank McEwen, John Goss and Parmenas Clark. A very large number of people were in attendance, quite a number of them coming from some distance in the country to show the last tributes of respect to one whose death is deeply lamented. The closing service at the grave was performed by the Foresters.

—A crew of telephone men have been working in Summerside for the past two or three weeks. 2,500 feet of new aerial cable erected containing 35 miles of copper wire. The main cable on Water St. East contains 104 wires each wire being insulated or separated from all others by being wrapped spirally with dry paper, and the whole enclosed in a lead sheath. With this system there will be two direct wires from the Central Office to each telephone. This will effectually balance the lines and do away with the humming noise occasioned by the Telephone and Electric Light wires being in proximity to each other. The switchboard will be of the Battery Call type. A new type of subscriber's instruments will be used, all of which will be equipped with long distance transmitters and receivers and subscribers will be able to signal the operator by merely removing the receiver from the hook. The act of hanging up the receiver gives a positive signal to the operator to disconnect. An additional repair man has been stationed at Summerside to insure repairs being attended to promptly. The Company expects to have the system completed some time in January. Improvements are also being made to the toll lines. Additional two wire metallic circuit has been completed between Charlottetown and Summerside and will be cut into service at once. A second circuit has been erected between Summerside and Richmond and all lines made metallic between these two points. A new metallic switchboard has also been installed at Richmond.
