**THE BIGGEST RANCH IN THE WORLD.**  
The biggest ranch in the world came into existence in Canada at the end of November from a private company procured from the Canadian Government the enormous area of 75,550 square miles of which they propose to raise cattle and perhaps sheep. The ground costs them a yearly rental of \$192,000 which figures out to four cents an acre.

The possibility of raising domesticated caribou generally known as reindeer, in northern Canada were first realized by Stefansson, the Canadian Arctic explorer. He also drew the Government of Canada's attention to the musk ox which yields valuable wool and good meat in spite of its musky smell, which, however, does not adhere to the meat when the animal is properly skinned.  
Plans were taken under consideration by the members of Parliament to start a station at Melville Island where Stefansson thought would be the best place to begin the experiment of raising the musk ox and caribou in the domesticated state. In the meantime, before these plans had been put into action, the private company above mentioned leased the enormous tract of 75,550 square miles north of the Churchill River in Hudson Bay territory.

In Alaska, twenty-seven years ago the United States Government imported 1,200 head of reindeer from Russia, and leased them on a cooperative basis to the Eskimo stations and individual Eskimo. This was the most successful undertaking of the kind in the history of the world. Today there are estimated to be 85,000 head of reindeer in Alaska. The natives have been made prosperous people, where formerly they lived wretchedly; all because of their taking up reindeer herding.  
The new company proposes to drive the initial herd of 1,500 overland from Alaska to the Churchill River country, a distance of 2,000 miles. This is a tremendous undertaking, it is calculated will require at least eighteen months. If successful, it will rank as the greatest feat of its kind. There is danger, however, of the animals being starved by the hostile wild life in July. The caribou and with its many many foxes, and other animals' tracks. The caribou is the most numerous of the animals which eat round holes in the animal's skin, making the summer hides useless. However, by October the caribou gets its winter coat which is valuable for clothing.

The barren land of Canada, ranging over an area of about a million square miles between the Mackenzie River and the Arctic Ocean and between the Arctic Ocean and the shores of Hudson Bay there are some 20,000,000 caribou in the wild state, a concourse of animals greater even than the buffalo which once roamed the plains to the southward. The Eskimo and Indians hunt over this immense territory, and the timber wolves prey on caribou. Also at Dawson City every autumn the rest of the world's attention is attracted to the caribou hunt. Despite this the caribou seem to be as numerous as ever; some naturalists believe that they are increasing in number. No words can adequately depict the view a great herd of these animals present when on the march. They cover the country over areas ten miles square. Some times a herd takes several weeks to pass a given point.  
The new ranching company's experiment will be watched with much interest, and, in view of the results of reindeer raising in Alaska, the attempt seems likely to be successful as the Churchill River country is very similar. The caribou or reindeer, give good milk, their flesh is excellent eating, their hides are worth about four dollars.
